## **Community Companion Home Providers Needed**

**Norwich, Connecticut** – In celebration of Family Caregivers Month in November, The Arc New London County is launching the Community Companion Home program, a new home-based support program for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD) and their families. An innovative outreach initiative that includes short videos and a social media campaign will run through the holiday season to describe and encourage families to apply.

Kathleen Stauffer, The Arc NLC's Chief Executive Officer, stresses the importance of this community project, noting that this is the right time of the year for such a launch. "Every day our team and volunteers support people with IDD in living their best lives. Now we invite the community to open their own homes via CCH. Families throughout New London County can help create a loving and nurturing environment where people with IDD can thrive in family homes just like the rest of us do every day."

Created by local journalist and videographer Brian Scott-Smith, The Arc NLC's promotional campaign harnesses the power of social media via personal stories from past and current CCH Providers. Explains Stauffer, "What better way to acknowledge the great work of these unsung heroes and to demonstrate the amazing world a CCH can offer both a family and a person with IDD? With the holidays around the corner, it's a perfect time to 'give' the gift of a new family."
