36th Annual Jack O'Keefe Memorial Strides Road Race Sets Record for The Arc New London County

Waterford, CT- The 36th annual Jack O'Keefe Memorial Strides Road Race at Camp Harkness in Waterford set new records for The Arc New London County. Hosted Sunday, October 6, the race brought out 526 runners. The proceeds from the race benefit programs at The Arc which would otherwise go unfunded.

For the 9th year, Outback Steakhouse served chicken, soup and salad for the hungry runners. As a result of many changes at the DDS, the race is now an event of the Cactus Jack Foundation and The Arc New London County.
